

## When is a Clearance for Service is required?

To determine if a position holder is required to have a Clearance for Service, read Schedule 1 of the <u>Professional Standards Uniform Regulations</u> and consider the role (and the tasks they perform), office and/or position of the individual in your parish context. The following questions could be used as a guide.

Is the role listed at Schedule 1 clause 2 of the Professional Standards Uniform Regulations?



Is the person performing a role, office or position that is providing "ministry to children"?

(Refer to the definitions of "Ministry to Children" in the definitions section of <u>Safe Ministry to</u> Children Canon)



Is the person required to hold a Working With Children Check? Is the person doing child-related work?

(Refer to section 7 of <u>Worker Screening Act 2020 (Vic)</u>, <u>Working with Children Check</u> website including When You Need a Check and Do I Need a Check?)
